Instructions:

READ – ANSWER - TAKE NOTES - MEMORIZE

Dear student of the Word of God, we encourage you to read! The time spent reading is surely one of the wisest investments you will ever make. It is worth the effort!

This booklet is designed to help you read the whole Bible in one year. Though it may seem difficult, it is not. If you set aside 20 minutes every day to read and meditate on God’s Word, you will complete the whole Bible in one year. If you have decided to follow this plan, here’s what you need to do:

1. Every day **read** the passage assigned for the day, and **answer** the question for that day in the space provided.
2. . If one of the passages you read impacts you in a particular way, please use the space provided labeled “Remaining thought” to **write** down how it impacted you. If you need more space, we encourage you to keep a separate journal of your Bible readings and prayers.
3. Every day of the week **memorize** the verse or the verses assigned for that week on the bottom of the page. If you memorize all the assigned verses, by the end of the year you will know Romans 8 and 12 entirely!

We wish you great success and perseverance as you pursue this spiritual discipline, and if you need help, or support as you follow this plan, don’t hesitate to ask one of the pastors.
